# 2019 ECMPS Changes

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## ❖ 2019 Q3 release

- ❖ Changes to the reporting of data during the use of substitute data
- ❖ System and component IDs are now required
- ❖ RLSO instructions have been posted
- ❖ Soft rollout – informational messages requiring reporting of System Component IDs during missing data
- ❖ 2020 Q1 informational messages may become critical
- ❖ Part of changes to the tracking unit and stack operating hours for QA

# 2019-2020 ECMPS Changes

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- ❖ 2019 Q4

- ❖ Refinement of hourly QA checks using new data

- ❖ 2020 Q1 - Load Check Changes

- ❖ HOUROP – 44 – Checks the presence of load range records
  - ❖ HOUROP – 45 – Calculates reported load range against reported load
  - ❖ HOUROP – 46 – Calculates reported load range against reported load common stacks

# Items of Note

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- ❖ Component ID Serial Numbers
  - ❖ Bad Data
  - ❖ Field audits
  - ❖ Currently unlocked
  - ❖ May be locked in 2020 release
  - ❖ Part 75 Policy Manual Question 12.2
- ❖ Why?

# Items outside ECMPS

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- ❖ Stratification tests – Appendix A Section 6.5.6 (b)
- ❖ §75.34 Units with add-on emission controls – required to establish control parameters and ranges for missing data purposes that are maintained on site in the MP

# 2020 and Beyond

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- ❖ ECMPS Reengineering
  - ❖ Potential reporting platform changes
  - ❖ Improved user experience
  - ❖ More flexible and efficient updates
- ❖ Any rule changes are a separate process
  - ❖ May not include reporting changes
